GOLF: Pace of Play Tip of the Month: Keep up with the group in front of you. Don't worry about the group behind you. Also remember 2/10/2. 2 hours on the front, 10 minutes at the turn, and 2 hours on the back!!

Attention all golfers, please remember to follow all cart rules during your rounds. This month the grass is greening and healing from a long winter. As you play, remember to fill your divots, repair your ball marks, and if that bunker you just walked by has a footprint rake it quick. If all of us follow these simple rules the course will be perfect and everyone will enjoy it even more.

Also, if you missed last month's newsletter please note the new system on the driving range now that we have beautiful new bag stands. The new system has you hitting in front the rope (not behind it like before) and staff is also asking that you only hit where the stations are. Our goal is to get the grass tee health stronger through better daily rotations and controlling the hitting patterns of daily use.

Now that season is in full swing remember that lots of events are going on from WGA Playday, MGA Men's League, Interclub Play, and Club Events. Golf Maintenance: We are in the process of repairing some areas around our bunkers. These are areas where the machine used to rake the bunkers enters and exits the bunker. Because our bunkers are designed to be so deep there are very few areas where it is possible for the trap rake to exit the bunker. Over time these areas have worn. We will be excavating these areas and regrading them. Once we have the area graded, we will use a wood edger to hold the shape of the new edge until the sod is established. These areas will be marked as ground under repair and should be played as such. Please do not walk in these areas to avoid any damage to the sod or the new bunker edge.

Court News: Mid-day Maintenance is extremely important during the hot summer months to keep our Har-Tru Courts in top condition.

Brushing a Har-Tru court redistributes the loose top-dressing material and smooths it out after play. We do this around 12:00 and 1:00pm (on a daily basis) and brushing also dries the court out so it should only be done just prior to watering or if the court is too wet.

We Water after brushing to keep the court firm and stable and ensures proper traction. Watering should take place as needed to keep court conditions optimal. This process takes around 1 to 1.5 hours per bank of two courts.
